



What is Comp-Up?

COMP-UP is a European Erasmus+ Project that aims to update the competences of Adult Education Professionals (AEP) who support low-qualified adult learners in the process of improving literacy, numeracy and digital skills. Moreover, COMP-UP offers possibilities to AEPs for keeping up the motivation of this target group by gathering already successfully implemented projects in the field.

What has been achieved in the last project months?

After completing the COMP-UP Tools Collection (https://comp-up.erasmus.site/wp-content/uploads/2020/10/Comp-Up-Tool-collection_EN.pdf), partners concentrated on the Training Curriculum development (https://comp-up.erasmus.site/wp-content/uploads/2021/07/COMP-UP-IO2-Curriculum_final-with-interactive-links.pdf), which will support AEPs in their work of developing guidance and motivation strategies for low-qualified adults. The Curriculum is made up by 5 modules which were jointly refined by partners:



- **Module 1:** Assessment of Key Competences
- **Module 2:** Facilitation techniques
- **Module 3:** Inclusive approaches in adult education
- **Module 4:** Involvement and motivation
- **Module 5:** Networking



As part of the Curriculum, partners will film separate, introductory Webinars for each module, which will be available in English with Italian, German, Polish, Romanian, Hungarian, Spanish and Swedish subtitles.

What comes next?

The Consortium is now working on finalising the **Motivational Toolkit** which will be a practical resource for implementing Motivational workshops to low-qualified adult learners. The Toolkit will contain, detailed, step-by-step description of the activities, resources needed and possible variations for implementation. Partners will engage in involving AEPs for piloting the already developed project outcomes within the upcoming piloting phases. Given the general, consortium wise applicable COVID19 restrictions, the partnership had to hold its 2nd and 3rd meetings online, which despite the online manner, were fully effective and successful. At the end of June and first week of July, a short-term joint staff training event will be held, also online, in order to pilot the developed project materials. In our next issue you will find out in more detail about the piloting events held in each partner country, alongside the experiences gathered at the short-term joint staff training event, which will be held online in the 22 June and 8th of July period.
